## Ridley vice-president active in business

Henry S. Gooderham, a Toronto businessman and vice-president of Ridley College, St. Catharines, died at home Monday. He was 83.

Before he retired eight years ago, Mr. Gooderham was president and director of the Dominion of Canada General Insurance Co. and the Casualty Co. of Canada, vice-president of Canada Permanent Trust Co. and Canada Permanent Mortgage Corp. and director of the Toronto-Dominion Bank and Excelsior Life Insurance Co.

Mr. Gooderham started his career as a laborer with Dominion Battery Co. Ltd. in 1919.

A Conservative and an Anglican, he was educated at Upper Canada College, Ridley College, Royal Military College and the University of Toronto.

During the First World War, he served overseas with the Canadian Army Medical Corps (Transport Department).

Mr. Gooderham's special interests included fishing and yachting. He was a member of the Royal Canadian Yacht Club, the Nekabong Hunting and Fishing Club, the York Club and the Kappa Alpha Society.

He leaves his wife, Dorothy, two sons, Stephen and Peter, and five grandchildren.
